Substitution Signal

- Referee does not hear request from coach, usually because on and facing opposite side of team benches.
- ♦ AR 1 Raises substitution flag
- ♦ AR 2 Mirrors, calls out to CR (if needed)



Substitution Control

- Subs at half with pinnies on
- Subs allowed, pinnies come off, subs wait for player to leave field (or be very close and away from other players)
- Permission to enter field by AR1 or CR



Your Quadrant/Half Only

- ♦ AR does not go past the half way line
- Goal is always on your right
- Stay on same side for both halves of game
- Only flags
 - ♦ Throw ins on your side of field
 - Goal Kick and Corner Kick on your Goal Line
 - Sprints for good goal scored in your net
